Timothy Rupert, hopes to complete the mission study and nominate members to the Pastoral Search Committee for election by the congregation by the end of August. The Pastoral Search Committee would then complete a Ministry Information Form which would be approved by the Session and the Committee on Ministry of the Presbytery, and formally begin the search process.
