Mission/Stewardship MISSIONARY NEWS - Bahrain

Andy Smothers, who attended our church while in seminary and was recently ordained in the Reformed Church of America (RCA), is now serving as the associate pastor of the National Evangelical Church in Bahrain, a church started by the RCA in 1893. His recent newsletter is in the Coffee Hour room. You can read about his work which includes discipleship, Christian education, Theological education, and Bible studies.

He writes that after a five-week introduction to the church's pastoral work, he has been thoroughly involved in the

ministry at the church. The Senior Pastor took an extended leave and then accepted a position in the States before the end of the year. Currently, they are looking for a Senior Pastor. The church continues to work at defining itself as they are composed of people from many traditions; they are also reaching out beyond their walls to provide medical care for the poor working in nearby labor camps, compounded not only by the extreme heat, but also by the Muslim restrictions on Christian outreach. Last year our church supported Andy. He will return to Iowa this summer and will try to connect with us in July or August. Please continue to pray for Andy and the ministry in Bahrain.
