


The 3 S's

SOCKS for babies, children, men, and women, large sized hand **SANITIZER**, **SHAMPOO** (large, not travel size).



Christmas Elves at Work


On Thursday, November 30th, the elves of FPC were hard at work decorating the church for the Advent season under the direction of Rachel Vander Broek.
